GENERAL INFORMATION

REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION SUBMISSION

1. Must have completed 8th grade
2. No junior college or athletes graduating prior to 2013
3. Must have at least a 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale

SOFTBALL PREFERRED HONORS

1. All-state, all-region, all-district, all-county, all-conference, MVP, coach awards
2. Member of a team that played in a national tournament

ACADEMIC HONORS

1. High GPA, high test scores, honors classes, honor society, who's who, leadership positions, etc.

NORTHEAST ACADEMIC CAMP AT PENNSBURY MINIMUMS*

1. SAT 1750/ACT 26/PSAT 175 (SAT or ACT test scores are strongly recommended for juniors and seniors.)
2. GPA 3.5 or better

*For the freshman & sophomores with no test scores, please review the list of requirements on the NFCA website. Look for the recruiting camp pages and then click on Northeast Academic Camp.

CRITERIA FOR CAMP SELECTION

1. Strength of submitted application
2. Seniority, with juniors and seniors receiving priority
3. Participating with team in the corresponding tournament
4. Date of submitted application (after applying the first three mentioned criteria)

ATHLETE NOTIFICATION

Athletes are notified after the specified camp's deadline. (Camp deadlines are listed on the front page of this brochure).

CAMP FEE

ADMINISTERED CAMPS: \$120 if accepted to one camp session. \$80 additional fee if accepted to a second session. Both the Northeast Academic and Pennsbury camp do not allow second session participation. ENDORSED CAMPS: \$100 for one session, \$75 additional for a second session. ALL endorsed camps allow the second session.

PAYMENT

Payment is requested only after the letter or email of acceptance is received.

SKILLS DEMONSTRATED ON CAMP DAY

1. Hit off of a pitching machine at 56-59 MPH
2. 60-foot sprint
3. Overhand throws clocked for MPH (except pitchers)
4. Infielders/Outfielders position play defense
5. Pitchers clocked for pitch speeds
6. Catchers pop-to-pop times and other catcher defensive drills

BATS Testing at administered camps will also include:

7. Agility measured by the shuttle run
8. Muscular strength measured by the grip strength dynamometer
9. Power measured by the Standing Broad Jump
10. Rotational Power measured by the medicine ball toss
11. Batted-ball velocity by hitting off a tee into a catch net
12. Body composition by imputing height, weight and age into computer.

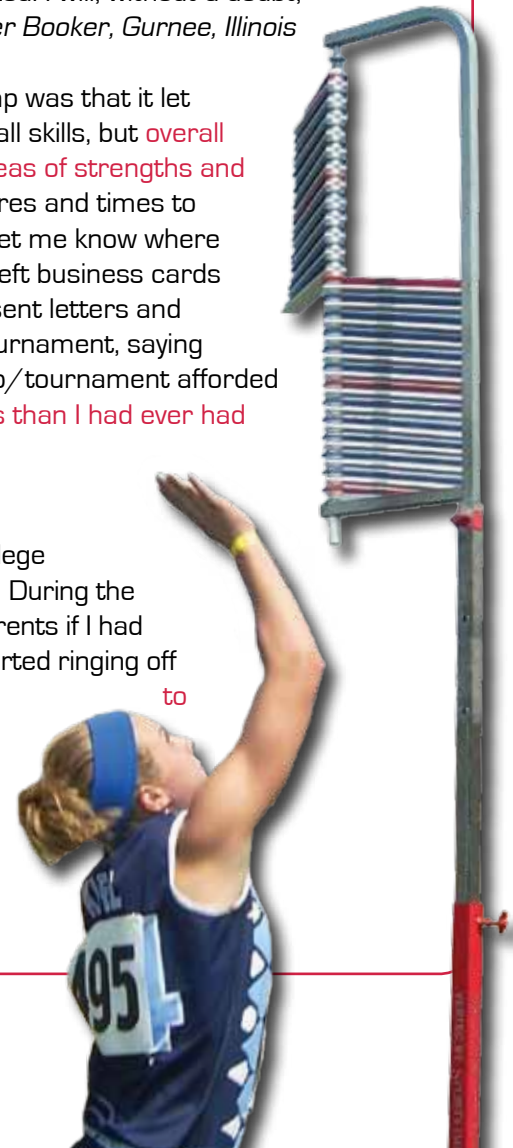
COLLEGE COACHES
